RESPONSIBILITIES:

UNDER the general supervision of the Manager for Protected Areas, provides support for monitoring the Pitons Management Area (PMA) and other Protected Areas (PA) through scheduled individual site visits and visits conducted as part of Monitoring Teams to ensure (a) compliance with the Limits of Acceptable Change Study (LACS) for the PMA (2013) and other relevant environmental management and regulatory instruments; and (b) effective implementation of Protected Area Management Plans.

DUTIES AND TASKS:

Works with the Manager, PA to:

Monitor physical developments within the PMA, especially those approved by the Development Control Authority (DCA) placing particular emphasis on their compliance with the LACS for the PMA (2013); and

Establish a system to monitor changes within the PMA using the important Viewpoints Methodology prescribed in the LACS for the PMA (2013) to ensure preservation of the PMA landscape and Outstanding Universal Value.

Assists the Manager, PA with the following activities:

Networking with the Ministry of Physical Development, Housing and Urban Renewal and other Government Departments to facilitate effective monitoring of development activities within the PMA:

Organising consultations targeted at the Soufriere community and environs and landowners to raise awareness of

The recommendations of the LACS for the PMA (2013) and the benefits to be derived from stakeholder compliance with these recommendations; and

Any other proposed development activities to be undertaken by government within the PMA and Environs and Soufriere Region generally;

Coordinating PA management activities with the Soufriere Marine Management Organisation, the Department of Forestry, and the Department of Fisheries to ensure that the integrity biodiversity and health of the marine environment of the Pitons Management Area are maintained and where possible enhanced;

Organising workshops, meetings and consultations with environmental management and community development agencies and stakeholder groups to build local consensus and foster community participation and stewardship in the PMA and PA generally;

Preparing the Sate of Conservation (SOC) Report to the World Heritage Committee (WHC);

Developing and implementing the following:

Public education and awareness programmes for the PMA and PA generally to facilitate greater dissemination of information on Protected Areas; and

Projects geared towards addressing threats to the biodiversity of the PMA and PA generally;

Conducting research that informs PA management activities such as; managing threats to PA biodiversity, assessing the impact of World Heritage Status on the PMA, assessing and managing PA carrying capacity etc.;

Prepares reports as follows:

Reports on site visits conducted within the PMA to include reporting on physical developments, natural changes, biological changes and the impact of human activities on the Protected Area to document observations, issues and concerns raised during monitoring visits as well as recommendations for addressing them; and

Quarterly and annual reports on all monitoring activities in Protected Areas using a prescribed format to ensure documentation of observations for record keeping and to provide information for follow-up actions.

Performs any other related duties as may be assigned by the Manager from time to time to fulfil the mandate of the Office of the Protected Areas Management.

CONDITIONS:

Congenial administrative office accommodation will be provided at the Protected Areas Management Office in Soufriere.

The Position is available on contract for an initial period of twelve (12) months with the possibility of extension upon satisfactory performance.



SAINT LUCIA GEOTHERMAL RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT SECTORS: Energy, Renewable Energy GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE Project ID: P149959

THE Government of Saint Lucia is expecting funding in the amount of two million United States dollars equivalent from the World Bank towards the cost of the Geothermal Resource Development Project, and it intends to apply part of the funding for payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project.

The development objective of the project is to provide support for the Government of Saint Lucia to make an informed decision regarding geothermal exploration and development in Saint Lucia by undertaking upstream preparatory activities. Such support would help the Government of Saint Lucia confirm areas for drilling, partner with a qualified developer, and design a geothermal exploration/resource confirmation program for sustainable implementation - all in line with good industry practices and international standards.

The project will include the following components:

Component 1: Upstream geothermal development preparation and project management. This component will aim at advancing surface level reconnaissance that is necessary to determine whether

several areas identified maybe suitable for geothermal exploration within the Qualibou region. It will also include a review of previous analysis such as geological, geophysical and geochemical surveys, as well as available data from previously drilled wells. The component will also initiate environmental and social evaluations, including stakeholder consultations, to ascertain baseline conditions and the steps that may be necessary to mitigate any impacts so that geothermal can be developed in a safe and sustainable manner. Funding will also be applied towards technical advisory support to coordinate the technical assessments and integrate the results in a pre-feasibility study. Funding will also be allocated to cover incremental operating costs for project implementation and management including hiring local specialists to manage grant activities, enhancing domestic capacity by transferring knowledge through onthe-job training and workshops:.

Component 2: Transaction and regulatory support. The component will support the GoSL in designing, structuring and negotiating an equitable agreement with a potential qualified geothermal developer; and will ensure a fair allocation of potential risks. It will also help facilitate initial off-take arrangements with the power company that is essential for moving forward with potential investments. The work will also help ensure that the legal and regulatory framework provides an adequate investment climate for a potential power project; and it will lead to the inclusion of geothermal as a part of LUCELEC's formal expansion plans, providing the certainty for investing in exploration drilling.

The project is expected to be completed by January 31, 2017.

Procurement of contracts financed by the World Bank will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits* (January 2011), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the guidelines. Consulting services will be selected

in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011).


