AND UPON THE COURT NOTING THAT:

- 1) a complaint was filed on 17 March 2010 alleging professional misconduct by the Respondent.
- 2) the matter being heard by the Disciplinary Committee on 27 October 2011.
- 3) the Committee ordered the Respondent to pay compensation in the sum of EC\$6,000.00 and costs in the sum of EC\$1,000.00 on or before 23 November 2011.
- 4) the Respondent failed to comply with the said order.

 - 4) Makes an application to be issued a practicing certificate.
- [3] There be no order as to costs.
- [4] The Registrar of the High Court shall take steps to publish notice of this order on the Gazette and inform all courts in Saint Lucia accordingly.
- [5] The Court Office shall file this Order.
