# SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2019, No. 108

[ 31st July, 2019 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 25(2) of the Income Tax Act, Cap. 15.02, the Minister responsible for finance, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

#### Citation and commencement

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Income Tax (Exemption) (Appointments) (Judicial and Legal Services Commission) Order, 2019.
  - (2) This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2019.

### Exemption

**2.** Section 25(1) of the Income Tax Act, Cap. 15.01 is amended by inserting the following paragraph for an exemption in its correct alphabetical sequence —

"any income accruing or any amount accrued by way of gratuity, on the termination of a contract, to an individual appointed by the Judicial and Legal Services Commission for his or her office as —

- (a) a magistrate;
- (b) the registrar of the High Court and the assistant registrar of the High Court;
- (c) a public officer in the department of the Attorney General, including
  - (i) the Solicitor General,
  - (ii) a Crown Counsel,
  - (iii) the Director of Legislative Drafting,
  - (iv) the Deputy Director of Legislative Drafting,
  - (v) a Legal Drafter,

- (vi) the Registrar of Companies and Intellectual Property
- (vii) the Deputy Registrar of Companies and Intellectual Property:
- (d) a public officer in the department of the Director of Public Prosecutions.".
