WHEREAS it is enacted by section 55 of the Constitution of Saint Lucia that the Governor-General may at any time prorogue Parliament;

And Whereas it is expedient that the said Parliament should be prorogued;

NOW THEREFORE, I, VICTOR E. GIRARD, O.B.E., Deputy Governor-General, do hereby proclaim that Parliament shall be and the same is hereby prorogued on the 22nd day of April, 2002.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Saint Lucia, at Government House in the city of Castries in the State of Saint Lucia this 17th day of April, two thousand and Two in the fifty first year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.
