

*Airport (Service Charge) (Amendment) Regulations***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2025, No. 81

[ 30th May, 2025 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 73 of the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority Act, Cap. 8.13, the Minister responsible for finance, on the recommendation of the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority, makes these Regulations:

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Airport (Service Charge) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.

**Amendment of Schedule 1**

2. The Airport (Service Charge) Regulations, Cap. 8.13 is amended by deleting Schedule 1 and replacing the following —

- (i) Anguilla,
  - (ii) Bermuda,
  - (iii) British Virgin Islands,
  - (iv) Cayman Islands,
  - (v) Turks and Caicos;
- (c) the French West Indies, consisting of —
- (i) Guadeloupe,
  - (ii) Martinique,
  - (iii) Marie Galante,
  - (iv) Saint Barthelemy,
  - (v) Saint Martin;
- (d) other Caribbean countries, consisting of —
- (i) St. Maarten,
  - (ii) Aruba,
  - (iii) Curacao,
  - (iv) Bonaire.

Persons travelling other than for Caribbean travel	US\$53 or the equivalent in Eastern Caribbean Dollars
Persons travelling for Caribbean travel	
From the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of June, 2025 to the 31 <sup>st</sup> day of December, 2025	US\$12.50 or the equivalent in Eastern Caribbean Dollars
From the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of January, 2026	US\$25 or the equivalent in Eastern Caribbean Dollars
