In exercise of the power conferred under section 9 of the Public Health Act, Cap. 11.01, the Minister responsible for health makes these Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Slaughterhouse) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations “principal Regulations” means the Public Health (Slaughterhouse) Regulations, Cap. 11.01.

Replacement of regulation 3

3. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is deleted and replaced with the following —

“Registration

3.—(1) A person shall not use premises as a slaughterhouse unless the premises are registered by the Board and a certificate of registration is issued to that person under these Regulations.

(2) A certificate of registration under paragraph (1) must be issued in the form set out in Schedule 1, on payment of a fee of one hundred dollars and this fee is non-transferable.”.

Amendment of regulation 13

4. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (3) the following new paragraph (4) —

“(4) An environmental health officer or a medical officer of health shall issue a certificate in the form set in Part 1

of Schedule 2 on payment of the fee set out in Part 2 of Schedule 2 in respect of the quantity of the carcass or other part of the carcass that has been condemned and seized under paragraph (3).”.

Amendment of regulation 16

- 5. Regulation 16 of the principal Regulations is amended —
 - (a) by deleting the words “\$120” and by replacing the words “five thousand dollars”;
 - (b) by deleting the word “3” and by replacing the word “six”.

Amendment of principal Regulations

6. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the word “inspector” wherever it appears and by replacing the words “environmental health officer”.

Insertion of new Schedule 1 and Schedule 2

7. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 16 the following new Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 —
