

Tourism Incentives (Sea Adventures Inc.) Order

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2012, No. 67

[17th July, 2012]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Sea Adventures Inc.) Order 2012.

Approved tourism product

2. The SNUBA Adventure Program is declared an approved tourism product.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax

3.— (1) Subject to subsection (2) and section 4, the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax is a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on all snorkeling and scuba equipment imported or purchased locally to facilitate the launching of the SNUBA Adventure Program.

(2) The declared benefit in subsection (1) —

(a) is applicable for a period of two years commencing on the 21st day of April, 2011 and terminating on the 20th day of April 2013; and

(b) is subject to the approval of a Bill of Quantities by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.

Condition

4. The declared benefit in section 3 is subject to the following conditions:

(a) that Sea Adventures Inc. obtains approval from the Ministry of Agriculture, Food Production, Fisheries and Rural Development; and

Tourism Incentives (Sea Adventures Inc.) Order

- (b) that Sea Adventures Inc. complies with all monitoring requirements specified by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
