

*Tourism Incentives (Dasheene (1988) Limited) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 92

[19th June, 2006]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30, the Minister responsible for Tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation and commencement

1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Dasheene (1988) Limited) Order 2006.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 07th day of November, 2005.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax

2. — (1) Subject to subsection (2), the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax shall be a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on —

- (a) all building materials, imported and/or locally purchased to refurbish and upgrade Ladera Hotel Resort and Spa and its central facilities and to construct ten villas;
- (b) furniture, fittings, fixtures, kitchen supplies, linen and drapery imported and/or locally purchased for the said Resort.

(2) The declared benefit in subsection (1) is —

- (a) applicable for a period of five years ending on 30th November 2010;
- (b) in the case of subsection (1)(a), subject to verification of the bill of quantities by the Ministry of Communications, Works, Transport and Public Utilities; and
- (c) in the case of subsection (1)(b), subject to verification by the Ministry of Tourism.

Declared benefit with regard to income tax

3. The declared benefit with regard to income tax shall be a one hundred percent relief of income tax accruing from the hotel's operation for a period of five years ending on 30th November 2010.
