

*Tourism Incentives (Carnival Sailing Ltd.) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2012, No. 62

[17th July, 2012]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Carnival Sailing Ltd.) Order 2012.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax

2.— (1) Subject to subsection (2) and section 3, the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax is a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on snorkeling and scuba equipment, boat equipment, electronic equipment and safety equipment imported or purchased locally.

(2) The declared benefit in subsection (1) —

- (a) is applicable for a period of one year commencing from the 27th day of June, 2011 and terminating on the 26th day of June, 2012; and
- (b) is subject to the approval of a Bill of Quantities by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.

Condition

3. The declared benefit in section 2 is subject to the condition that Carnival Sailing Ltd. complies with all monitoring requirements of the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
