

**SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2004, No. 91

[ 22th December, 2004 ]

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 193 of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Act 2003, No. 10 of 2003, the Minister responsible for Transport makes the following Regulations —

**Citation**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Ticketable Offences) Regulations 2004.

**Interpretation**

**2.** In these Regulations “Act” means the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Act 2003, No. 10 of 2003.

**Designation of ticketable offences**

- 3.** The traffic offences designated as ticketable offences shall be—
- (a) in the case of ticketable offences not related to parking referred to in section 91 of the Act, as listed in Part I of the First Schedule;
  - (b) in the case of ticketable offences related to parking referred to in section 92 of the Act, as listed in Part II of the First Schedule.

**Form of ticket**

**4.** The form of the ticket shall, in accordance with section 94 of the Act, be as prescribed in the Second Schedule.

**OFFENCES NOT RELATED TO PARKING**

1. Using unregistered vehicle contrary to section 61.
2. Operating a motor vehicle in an unroadworthy condition contrary to section 63.
3. Violation of conditions of registration contrary to section 64.
4. Using or permitting use of motor vehicle without a motor vehicle or trailer licence number contrary to section 65.
5. Driving motor vehicle without valid driver's licence or permit contrary to section 66.
6. Non-compliance with traffic control devices and directions contrary to section 71.
7. Driving without due care and without consideration contrary to section 74.
8. Driving while intoxicated contrary to section 75.
9. Speeding contrary to section 76.
10. Littering contrary to section 81.
11. Refusal or failure to permit examination of licence, permit or ID contrary to section 85.
12. Operation of motor vehicle without pollution control contrary to section 87.

Payments by mail are to be by check or money order made payable to the District Court. **Do not send cash.** *Please print the ticket number on the front of the check or money order.*

**3. PLEA OF NOT GUILTY**

If you wish to plead not guilty, **you must notify** the court at the address and telephone number as shown below **WITHIN 14 DAYS** after being served with this ticket. When responding to this ticket, you may indicate that the attendance of the traffic officer who completed the ticket is required for the purpose of cross-examination at trial.  Check box for attendance of Traffic officer.

**4. FAILURE TO PAY**

Consequent on your failure to pay the fixed penalty specified in paragraph 1 you, are hereby bound over to appear before the Magistrate of the district Court sitting at on the day of at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon to answer the complaint.

If your fail to appear, the Magistrate may issue a warrant of arrest to compel your attendance.
