

*Standards Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2003, No. 60

[ 21st July, 2003 ]

In exercise of the power conferred by section 19 of the Standards Act No.14 of 1990, the Minister responsible for standard matters, makes this Order :

**Citation and commencement**

1. — (1) This Order may be cited as the Standards Order 2003.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 2001.

**Declaration and purpose of Standards**

2. — (1) The Standards listed in Section A, Band C of the Schedule are declared to be compulsory effective October, 2001.

(2) The purposes for the standard listed in Section A of the Schedule are —

- (a) to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety;
- (b) to prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading advertising or labelling;
- (c) to require adequate information to be given to the consumer or user.

(3) The purposes for the standard listed in Section B of the Schedule are:

- (a) to prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading advertising or labelling.
- (b) to require adequate information to be given to the consumer or user.

(4) The purposes for the standard listed in Section C of the Schedule are —

- (a) to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety;
- (b) to ensure quality in goods produced for export.
