

*Tourism Incentives (Bay Gardens Limited) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2017, No. 86

[ 21st August, 2017 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Bay Gardens Limited) Order, 2017.

**Approved tourism project**

2. The expansion and refurbishment of —
- (a) the Bay Gardens Hotel;
  - (b) the Bay Gardens Inn; and
  - (c) the Bay Gardens Beach Resort,
- is declared an approved tourism project.

**Declared benefit with regard to import duty**

3.—(1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), the declared benefit with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on —

- (a) building materials, furniture, fixtures, fittings, soft furnishings, equipment, industrial (hotel) operating equipment and appliances for use in the approved tourism project;
  - (b) watercraft equipment for Bay Gardens Beach Resort.
- (2) Subject to subsection (3), the declared benefit under —
- (a) subsection (1)(a) is applicable for a period of three years commencing from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2017 and terminating on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2020; and

- (b) subsection (1)(b) is applicable for a period of one year commencing from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2017 and terminating on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2018.
- (3) The declared benefit under subsection (1) is subject to the conditions that the management of Bay Gardens Limited —
  - (a) submits Bills of Quantities to the Department of Tourism, Information and Broadcasting and obtains prior approval of the Bills of Quantities by the Department of Tourism, Information and Broadcasting prior to the purchase or importation of the items for use in the approved tourism project; and
  - (b) complies with all monitoring and licensing requirements specified by the Department of Tourism, Information and Broadcasting.
