

*Elections (Amendment) Regulations***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2011, No. 83

[22nd August, 2011]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 94 of the Elections Act, Cap. 1.02 the Minister responsible for matters relating to the registration of voters and the election of members of the House, makes these Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Elections (Amendment) Regulations 2011.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations “principal Regulations” means the Elections Regulations, Cap. 1.02.

Amendment of regulation 10

3. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is amended by adding the following subregulations immediately after subregulation (2):

- “(3) If by reason of physical disability, an applicant is unable to visit a registration office or centre for the electoral district, that applicant may apply for registration at his or her place of residence.
- (4) In subregulation (3), “place of residence” means a dwelling house or an institution.”.

Amendment of regulation 46

4. Regulation 46(3) of the principal Regulations is amended by –

(a) deleting paragraph (c) and replacing it with the following:

“(c) any Returning Officer of an electoral district where the election was contested: \$2,400;”;

(b) deleting paragraph (e) and replacing it with the following:

“(e) any Election Clerk of an electoral district where the election was contested: \$1,200;”;

Elections (Amendment) Regulations

- (c) deleting paragraph (g) and replacing it with the following:
“(g) any Assistant Election Clerk of an electoral district where the election was contested: \$800;”;
- (d) deleting paragraph (i) and replacing it with the following:
“(i) any Presiding Officer: \$700;”;
- (e) deleting paragraph (j) and replacing it with the following:
“(j) any Poll Clerk: \$550;”;
- (f) deleting paragraph (k) and replacing it with the following:
“(k) any Assistant Poll Clerk: \$350;”.
