

*Tourism Incentives (Startrek Charters Limited) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2016, No. 37

[11th April, 2016]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Startrek Charters Limited) Order, 2016.

Approved tourism project

2. The acquisition of electrically powered boats and associated accessories for the provision of tourist recreational services by Startrek Charters Limited is declared an approved tourism project.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty

3.—(1) Subject to subsection (2) and section 4, the declared benefit with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on the importation of –

- (a) ten electrically powered boats; and
- (b) associated accessories, including –
 - (i) batteries,
 - (ii) battery chargers, and
 - (iii) life vests,

to be used solely for Startrek Charters Limited.

(2) The declared benefit granted in subsection (1) is applicable for a period of three years commencing from the 4th day of November, 2013 and terminating on the 3rd day of November, 2016.

Tourism Incentives (Startrek Charters Limited) Order

Conditions

4. The declared benefit in section 3 is subject to the conditions that —

- (a) a Bill of Quantities is submitted to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries for approval prior to the importation of the items for the approved tourism project;
- (b) the management of Startrek Charters Limited submit a bi-annual report to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries from the date of commencement of the approved tourism project; and
- (c) Startrek Charters Limited complies with all other monitoring requirements specified by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
