

*Tourism Incentives (Diamond View) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 109

[ 26th June, 2006 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act 1996, No. 7, the Minister responsible for Tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Diamond View) Order 2006.

**Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax**

2.— (1) Subject to subsection (2), the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax shall be a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on —

- (a) fifteen Peugeot mopeds;
- (b) all safety equipment to include eighteen sets of helmets, elbow pads, knee pads and security devices; and
- (c) all office equipment needed for the establishment of the office of the Diamond View.

(2) The declared benefits in subsection (1) are applicable for a period of one year ending on 31st December 2006.
