A PROCLAMATION

PH.D, LL.D (HON.) *GOVERNOR-GENERAL*.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 54 (1) of the Constitution of Saint Lucia that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Saint Lucia and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall appoint by Proclamation;

AND WHEREAS it is now expedient that a session of the said Parliament should now be held;

NOW THEREFORE I, CALLIOPA PEARLETTE LOUISY, Governor-General of Saint Lucia, by this Proclamation do hereby appoint –

- (1) that a session shall be held on Tuesday the 9th day of January, 2007, for the dispatch of public business;
- (2) that the first meeting of the House of Assembly shall commence at 9 o'clock in the forenoon on Tuesday, 9th day of January, 2007, at the Parliament Building in the City of Castries;
- (3) that the first meeting of the Senate shall commence at 10 o'clock in the forenoon on Tuesday, the 9th day of January, 2007, at the Parliament Building in the City of Castries;

AND THE MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all Her Majesty's Officers, Ministers and loving subjects in Saint Lucia and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.
