

*Tourism Incentives (Drake Intertrade Ltd.) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2016, No. 38

[11th April, 2016]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Drake Intertrade Ltd.) Order, 2016.

Approved tourism project

2. The renovation of Capella at Marigot Bay Hotel by Drake Intertrade Ltd. is declared an approved tourism project.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and excise tax

3.—(1) Subject to subsection (3) and section 4, the declared benefit with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on all resort and marine building or construction materials, construction equipment, plant and machinery, furniture, fixtures, equipment, finishings, fittings, linen, drapery, appliances, kitchen supplies, cutlery and glassware.

(2) Subject to subsection (3) and section 4, the declared benefit with regard to import duty and excise tax is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty and excise tax on the importation of —

- (a) ten golf carts; and
- (b) one utility service vehicle to transport food, linen, spare parts and other goods at Capella at Marigot Bay Hotel.

(3) Subject to section 4, the declared benefits granted in subsections (1) and (2) are —

- (a) applicable for a period of five years commencing from the 7th day of November, 2012 and terminating on the 6th day of November, 2017;

- (b) subject to the approval of a Bill of Quantities submitted to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries prior to the importation of the items for the approved tourism project.

Conditions

4. The declared benefits in section 3 are subject to the conditions that —

- (a) in the case of section 3(2)(b), the vehicle bears the visible signage of Drake Intertrade Ltd. and is subject to the licensing regime of the Ministry of Infrastructure, Port Services and Transport; and
- (b) Drake Intertrade Ltd. complies with the monitoring requirements of the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
