

Post Office (Amendment) Regulations

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2004, No. 5

[9th February, 2004]

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 of the Post Office Ordinance, Chapter 145, Cabinet makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 2004.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations —

“principal Regulations” means the Post Office Regulations, Chapter 145.

Amendment of Regulation 92

3. Regulation 92 of the Principal Regulations is amended by adding a new regulation 92 (b) after regulation 92 (a) as follows —

- “92 (b) (i) The head of a household desiring to have a community letter box assigned to him or her shall apply to the Postmaster General.
- (ii) The charge for a community box shall be payable yearly in advance and shall be \$10.00 per annum.
- (iii) Should the key be lost, the renter will be required to pay \$10.00 for a new one or to repay to the Postmaster General the cost of replacing the lock to the box where a duplicate key is not payable.”

Amendment of Third Schedule

4. The Third Schedule of the Principal Regulations is replaced as follows —
