A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 56 of the Constitution of Saint Lucia, it is provided that a general election of members of the House of Assembly shall be held at such time within three months after any dissolution of Parliament as the Governor-General may appoint;

AND WHEREAS Parliament was dissolved on the 17th day of November, 2006, by Proclamation published in an Extraordinary Gazette dated the 17th day of November, 2006;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CALLIOPA PEARLETTE LOUISY Governor-General of Saint Lucia, by virtue of powers conferred upon me, hereby appoint the 30th day of November, two thousand and six for the nomination of candidates and the 11th day of December, two thousand and six for the holding of a poll for the general election of members of the House of Assembly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Saint Lucia at Government House in the City of Castries, in the State of Saint Lucia this 17th day of November, 2006 in the fifty-fifth year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.
