

*Elections (Amendment) Regulations***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 173

[ 27th November, 2006]

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 94 of the Elections Act, Cap. 1.02, the Minister to whom matters relating to the registration of voters and the election of members of the House of Assembly, makes these Regulations:

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Elections (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

**Interpretation**

2. In these Regulations “principal Regulations” means the Elections Regulations, Cap 1.02.

**Amendment of regulation 46**

3. Regulation 46(3) of the principal Regulations is amended by —
- (a) deleting the number “1,400” appearing in paragraph (c) and substituting the number “2100”;
  - (b) deleting the number “850” appearing in paragraph (d) and substituting the number “1,200”;
  - (c) deleting the number “700” appearing in paragraph (e) and substituting the number “1,050”;
  - (d) deleting the number “450” appearing in paragraph (f) and substituting the number “675”;
  - (e) deleting the number “450” appearing in paragraph (g) and substituting the number “675”;
  - (f) deleting the number “300” appearing in paragraph (h) and substituting the number “450”;
  - (g) deleting the number “400” appearing in paragraph (j) and substituting the number “600”;
  - (h) deleting the number “300” appearing in paragraph (j) and substituting the number “450”;

*Elections (Amendment) Regulations*

- (i) deleting the number “200” appearing in paragraph (k) and substituting the number “300”.

**Amendment of regulation 48**

4. Regulation 48(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting the following as paragraph (d):

- “(d) \$ 30 - where instructions are received from the Chief Elections Officer or the Returning Officer for each instruction session received.”.

**Amendment of regulation 51**

5. Regulation 51 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the number “40” appearing in that section and substituting the number “150”.
