

*Tourism Incentives (St. Lucia Horse and Carriage) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 105

[19th June, 2006]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for Tourism with the approval of Cabinet makes this Order:

Citation and commencement

1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (St. Lucia Horse and Carriage) Order 2006.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 5th day of December, 2005.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax

2. — (1) Subject to subparagraph (2), the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax shall be a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on the following items to be imported by St. Lucia Horse and Carriage –

- (a) three carriages;
- (b) two horses;
- (c) one trailer;
- (d) carriage harnesses, accessories and parts;
- (e) bits;
- (f) shoes and nails;
- (g) shoe pads; and
- (h) vitamins and mineral blocks.

(2) The declared benefit in subparagraph (1) is applicable until 1st December 2006.
