STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2002, No. 80

[2nd September, 2002]

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 56 of the Metrology Act 2000, No. 17, the Minister responsible for Commerce, makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Metrology (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002.

Replacement of Third Schedule

2. The Metrology (Fees) Regulations, 2002, No. 55 is amended by deleting the Third Schedule and substituting the following —

 “THIRD SCHEDULE

(Regulation 5)

**(Fees for the testing, verification and stamping of weights,
 measures or weighing and measuring instruments - section 56)**

Maximum Capacities	Fee
Scales up to 10kg inclusive (up to 22 lbs inclusive)	\$25.00
Scales above 10kg to 50kg inclusive (above 22 lbs to 110 lbs inclusive)	\$45.00
Scales above 50kg to 150kg inclusive (110 lbs to 331 lbs inclusive)	\$125.00
Scales above 150kg to 250kg inclusive (331 lbs to 551 lbs inclusive)	\$175.00
Scales above 250kg to 350kg inclusive (551 lbs to 772 lbs inclusive)	\$275.00
Scales above 350kg to 450kg inclusive (772 lbs to 992 lbs inclusive)	\$375.00
Scales above 450kg to 550kg inclusive (992 lbs to 1213 lbs inclusive)	\$475.00
Scales above 550kg to 1500kg inclusive (1213 lbs to 3307 lbs inclusive)	\$575.00
Scales above 1500kg to 2500kg inclusive (3307 lbs to 5512 lbs inclusive)	\$675.00
Scales above 2500kg (above 5512 lbs)	\$800.00

Weights of denomination greater than 2 kg (4 lbs)	\$30.00 each
