

Tourism Development (Bel Jou (St. Lucia) Limited) Order

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2025, No. 24

[24th February, 2025]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 81(a), 83(1) and 86(1)(a) of the Tourism Development Act, No. 1 of 2024, the Minister responsible for tourism, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Development (Bel Jou (St. Lucia) Limited) Order, 2025.

Approved tourism investment

2. The procurement of one 2023 Nissan Urvan Vehicle to be solely used for the operations of Bel Jou (St. Lucia) Limited is declared an approved tourism investment.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty

3.—(1) Subject to subsection (2) and section 4, the declared benefit for the approved tourism investment with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on the procurement of one 2023 Nissan Urvan Vehicle.

(2) The declared benefit under subsection (1) is applicable for a period of one year commencing from the 1st day of October, 2024 and terminating on the 30th day of September, 2025.

Conditions

4. The declared benefit under section 3 is subject to the conditions that —

- (a) the 2023 Nissan Urvan Vehicle has visible signage of no less than 50cm x 50cm of the logo “Bel Jou (St. Lucia) Limited” on each side of the vehicle;
- (b) the management of Bel Jou (St. Lucia) Limited —
 - (i) submits, to the Ministry of Tourism, Investment, Creative Industries, Culture and Information —

- (A) a project report within thirty days of completion of the approved tourism investment;
 - (B) and the Department of Statistics, data to assess the impact on the tourism sector for monitoring and compiling of the Tourism Satellite Account,
- (ii) informs the Ministry of Tourism, Investment, Creative Industries, Culture and Information of any changes related to the approved tourism investment,
- (iii) complies with —
- (A) the licensing requirements of the Transport Division of the Department of Infrastructure, Ports and Transport;
 - (B) all other monitoring requirements and certification requirements of the Ministry of Tourism, Investment, Creative Industries, Culture and Information and any other Government agency.
