

*Tourism Incentives (Ciceron Management Limited) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2019, No. 160

[ 23rd December, 2019 ]

In exercise of the powers conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for Tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Ciceron Management Limited) Order, 2019.

**Approved tourism project**

2. The acquisition of three vehicles by Ciceron Management Limited for providing transportation services to visitors is declared an approved tourism project.

**Declared benefit with regard to customs duty**

3.—(1) Subject to subsection (2), the declared benefit with regard to customs duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of customs duty on —

- (a) one 2019 16-Seater Toyota Hiace Bus;
- (b) one 2019 Chevrolet Trax Mini SUV; and
- (c) one 2017 DAF Box Truck.

(2) The declared benefit —

- (a) under subsection (1) is applicable for a period of one year, commencing from the 31st day of July, 2019 and terminating on the 30th day of July, 2020;
- (b) is subject to the conditions that —
  - (i) each vehicle bears the name and logo of Sandals Golf Resort and Spa in a dimension not less than 50cm x 50cm visibly displayed on both sides of each vehicle; and

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- (ii) the management of Ciceron Management Limited complies with the monitoring and licensing requirements of the Ministry of Tourism, Information and Broadcasting, Culture and Creative Industries, the transport division of the Ministry of Economic Development, Transport and Civil Aviation and any other relevant Government agency.
