

*Customs (Amendment) Regulations***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2007, No. 7

[21st February, 2007]

In exercise of the power conferred by section 141 of the Customs (Control and Management) Act, Cap. 15.05, the Minister charged with the responsible for customs, makes these Regulations—

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations 2007.

Substitution of regulation 75

2. Regulation 75 of the Customs Regulations, Cap. 15.05 is amended by —

- (a) deleting the words “40 fluid ounces in all” appearing in paragraph (a) and replacing the words “1.14 litre”;
- (b) deleting the words “1/2 pound” appearing in paragraph (b) and replacing the words “250g”;
- (c) deleting the full stop appearing at the end of paragraph (d) and replacing a semi-colon; and
- (d) inserting immediately after paragraph (d) the following:
 - “(e) cigarillos not exceeding 100 in number;
 - (f) perfume not exceeding 250ml;
 - (g) toilet water not exceeding 250ml.”

Amendment of Schedule 2

2. Schedule 2 of the Customs Regulations, Cap. 15.05 are amended by deleting Form No. 15 and substituting the following —
