

*Standards (Compulsory Standard) (No. 2) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2004, No. 76

[1st November, 2004]

In exercise of the power conferred by section 19 of the Standards Act No. 14 of 1990, the Minister responsible for Standards Matters makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Standard (Compulsory Standard) (No.2) Order, 2004.

Declaration of compulsory standard

2.— (1) The following standards are declared compulsory with effect from 1st September, 2004 —

SLNS 12 : 2003	Standard Specification for Rum
SLNS 51 : 2002	Standard Specification for Christmas Tree and other Decorative Lighting Outfits
SLNS 77 : 2003	Standard for Brewery Products
SLNS 79 : 2004	Standard for Carbonated Beverages

(2) The intended purposes of the standards referred to in subparagraph (1) are to —

- (a) protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety;
- (b) prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading advertising or labelling;
- (c) require adequate information to be given to the consumer or user;
- (d) ensure quality in goods produced for export;
- (e) generally ensure the quality of goods and services.
