

Tourism Incentives (Southern Taxi Association) Order

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2012, No. 68

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Southern Taxi Association) Order 2012.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and excise tax

2. Subject to section 3, the declared benefit with regard to import duty and excise tax is —

- (a) a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and excise tax on the purchase of two Toyota Coaster 30-seater coaches, 2010 model; and
- (b) a fifty percent waiver of import duty and excise tax on the purchase of a Toyota Coaster 30-seater coach, 2003 model and a Toyota Coaster 30-seater coach, 2005 model.

Conditions

3. The declared benefit in section 2 is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) that Southern Taxi Association submits a comprehensive bi-annual report to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries from the 6th day of December, 2010; and
- (b) that the management of Southern Taxi Association complies with all other monitoring requirements specified by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
