

*Tourism Incentives (Choc Bay Park Limited) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2016, No. 41

[ 11th April, 2016 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Choc Bay Park Limited) Order, 2016.

**Approved tourism project**

2. The acquisition by Choc Bay Park Limited of a catamaran and safety equipment for the provision of tourist recreational services by St. James's Club Morgan Bay is declared an approved tourism project.

**Declared benefit with regard to import duty**

3.—(1) Subject to subsection (2) and section 4, the declared benefit with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on a catamaran vessel and safety equipment imported for the exclusive use of St. James's Club Morgan Bay.

(2) The declared benefit granted in subsection (1) is –

- (a) applicable for a period of three years commencing from the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014 and terminating on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017; and
- (b) subject to the approval of a Bill of Quantities submitted to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries prior to the importation of the items for the approved tourism project.

**Conditions**

4. The declared benefit in section 3 is subject to the conditions that –

- (a) the management of St. James’s Club Morgan Bay submits a bi-annual report to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries from the date of commencement of the approved tourism project; and
- (b) the management of St. James’s Club Morgan Bay complies with all other monitoring and licensing requirements specified by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries and any other relevant Government agency.
