

*Extradition (Surrender of Fugitive) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2020, No. 131

[31st August, 2020]

WHEREAS it is provided under section 27(1) of the Extradition Act, Cap. 2.10 that the Attorney General may, by order under his hand, direct a person who has the custody of a fugitive committed for surrender, to surrender the fugitive to a person named in the order, as is in the opinion of the Attorney General, authorized to receive the fugitive in the name and on behalf of a Commonwealth country or foreign State;

AND WHEREAS on the 15th day of July, 2020 a Senior Magistrate ordered Sebastian Day to be surrendered to the United States of America to stand trial on charges of serious offences committed in that country;

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of August, 2020 an application, by Sebastian Day, for the issue of a writ of Habeas Corpus was dismissed by the High Court;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 27(1) of the Extradition Act, Cap. 2.10 and being of the opinion that Milton Desir, Commissioner of Police is authorized to receive Sebastian Day on behalf of the United States of America, the Attorney General makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Surrender of Fugitive) Order, 2020.

Surrender of fugitive

2. The Director of the Bordelais Correctional Facility is directed to surrender Sebastian Day to Milton Desir, Commissioner of Police on behalf of the United States of America.
