

*Customs Duties (Amendment of Schedule 4) (No. 2) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

In exercise of the power conferred under section 10 of the Customs (Duties) Act, Cap.15.04, the Minister responsible for finance makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Duties) (Amendment of Schedule 4) (No. 2) Order 2012.

Amendment of Schedule 4

2. Schedule 4 of the Customs Duties Act, Cap.15.04 is amended by deleting the rates of duty for the items in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and replacing them with the rates of duty in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
