

## SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 17

[ 13th March, 2006 ]

WHEREAS paragraph 3(a) of the Constitution of Saint Lucia– Resolution of the House of Assembly and the Senate on the Establishment of a Commission to Review and Reform the Constitution of Saint Lucia, Statutory Instrument No. 50 of 2004 was inadvertently worded as follows:

“3. That in the performance of its functions, the Commission shall govern itself as follows:

- (a) no member or officer of the House of Assembly shall not be eligible for membership of the Commission;”;

AND WHEREAS the correct wording of paragraph 3(a) of the said Resolution should be as follows:

“3. That in the performance of its functions, the Commission shall govern itself as follows:

- (a) a member or officer of the House of Assembly shall not be eligible for membership of the Commission;”.

BE IT RESOLVED that Parliament hereby amends the said Resolution to correct the wording of paragraph 3(a) as follows:

“3. That in the performance of its functions, the Commission shall govern itself as follows:

- (a) a member or officer of the House of Assembly shall not be eligible for membership of the Commission;”.
