

*Metrology (Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2002, No. 86

[ 14th October, 2002 ]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 56 of the Metrology Act 2000, No. 17 the Minister responsible for Commerce makes the following Regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Metrology (Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2002.

**Replacement of Third Schedule**

2. The Metrology (Fees) Regulations, 2002, No. 55 is amended by deleting the Third Schedule and substituting the following —

**“THIRD SCHEDULE***(Regulation 5)*

**(Fees for the testing, verification and stamping of weights, measures or weighing and measuring instruments - section 56)**

<b>Weighing instrument of Maximum Capacity (Max) up to</b>	<b>Fee</b>
Weighing instrument up to 10kg inclusive (up to 22 lbs inclusive)	\$25.00
Weighing instrument above 10kg to 50kg inclusive (above 22 lbs to 110 lbs inclusive)	\$45.00
Weighing instrument above 50kg to 150kg inclusive (above 110 lbs to 331 lbs inclusive)	\$125.00
Weighing instrument above 150kg to 250kg inclusive (above 331 lbs to 551 lbs inclusive)	\$175.00
Weighing instrument above 250kg to 350kg inclusive (above 551 lbs to 772 lbs inclusive)	\$275.00
Weighing instrument above 350kg to 450kg inclusive (above 772 lbs to 992 lbs inclusive)	\$375.00
Weighing instrument above 450kg to 550kg inclusive (above 992 lbs to 1213 lbs inclusive)	\$475.00
Weighing instrument above 550kg to 1500kg inclusive (above 1213 lbs to 3307 lbs inclusive)	\$575.00

Weighing instrument above 1500kg to 2500kg inclusive (above 3307 lbs to 5512 lbs inclusive)	\$675.00
Weighing instrument above 2500 kg inclusive (above 5512 lbs)	\$800.00
<b>Verification of Weights</b>	
Weights of denomination up to 2 kg (4 lbs)	\$10.00 each
Weights of denomination greater than 2 kg (4 lbs)	\$30.00 each
<b>Fuel Dispensing Instruments</b>	
Petrol Dispensers	\$75.00 per dispenser (hose).”.
