### **A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 55 of the Constitution of Saint Lucia  
that the Governor-General may at any time prorogue Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that Parliament should be prorogued;

NOW THEREFORE I, CALLIOPA PEARLETTE LOUISY, Governor-General,  
do hereby proclaim that Parliament shall be prorogued on the 18th day  
of April, 2006 and the same is hereby prorogued.

of Saint Lucia this 12th day of April, 2006 in the fifty-  
fifth year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth  
the Second.
