

*Tourism Incentives (Sweet Shaves Apartments) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 99

[19th June, 2006]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3 and 8 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30, the Minister responsible for Tourism, with the approval of Cabinet makes this Order:

Citation and commencement

1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Sweet Shaves Apartment) Order 2006.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th day of February, 2006.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax

2.— (1) Subject to subsection (2), the declared benefit with regard to import duty and consumption tax shall be a one hundred percent waiver of import duty and consumption tax on —

- (a) all building materials purchased locally or imported, for Sweet Shaves Apartments.
- (b) all equipment, furniture and fixtures imported or locally purchased for the said project.

(2) The declared benefit in subsection (1) is —

- (a) applicable until 31st January 2006;
- (b) in the case of subsection 1(a), subject to approval of the bill of quantities by the Ministry of Communications, Works, Transport and Public Utilities; and
- (c) in the case of subsection 1(b), subject to verification and approval of the bill of quantities by the Ministry of Tourism.
