

Legal Profession (Eligibility) (Nichola George Benjamin) Order

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2011, No. 30

[9th May, 2011]

WHEREAS it is provided by section 16 (1) of the Legal Profession Act, Cap. 2.04 that the Attorney General may, by Order published in the *Gazette*, specify that a person who is a citizen or a national of a country other than Saint Lucia who has obtained the qualifications prescribed by law shall be eligible to be admitted by the High Court to practice law in Saint Lucia;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by section 16 (2) of the same Act that the Attorney General shall not make an Order unless the Attorney General is satisfied after consultation with the Chief Justice that the person is a citizen or a national of a country the laws of which give reciprocal treatment to a citizen of Saint Lucia in relation to admission to practice law in the country;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 16 (1) and (2) of the Legal Profession Act, Cap. 2.04 and on being satisfied that Nichola George Benjamin is eligible to be admitted by the High Court to practice law in Saint Lucia, the Attorney General hereby makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility) (Nichola George Benjamin) Order 2011.

Eligibility

2. Nichola George Benjamin is declared eligible to be admitted by the High Court to practice law in Saint Lucia.
