STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2006, No. 2

[23rd January, 2006]

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 of the Tourist (Duty Free Shopping System) 1986, No. 23, Cabinet makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourist (Duty Free Shopping System) Order 2006.

Interpretation

2. In this Order “Act” means the Tourist (Duty Free Shopping System) Act 1986, S.I. No. 23.

Amendment to Part I of the First Schedule

3. Part I of the First Schedule to the Act is amended by inserting the following additional goods and equipments in the correct numerical sequence:

- “41. Stainless - steel kitchen, restaurant and bar equipment, chef’s knives, chafing dishes, chillers, food warmers, freezers and elegant tableware.
42. Guest room minibars or fridges, coffeemakers, hairdryers, electric irons, linens, towels, clock radio and television.
43. Furniture for lobby or reception areas, guest room suites, restaurant, lounges, bars, convention and banquet rooms.
44. Patio and poolside furniture, or spiral staircases, and heavy duty steel lockers.
45. Swimming pool cleaning and janitorial chemicals and equipment.
46. Security surveillance (CCTV) systems, guest room electronic security safes.
47. Industrial laundry equipment – stainless steel washers, dryers and flat irons.

Tourist (Duty Free Shopping System) Order

48. Jacuzzi (Hydromassage) bath and spas, plumbing ware for kitchens and bathrooms.
49. Audio and video equipment: large screen televisions, VCR's, and DVD players and plasma TV systems, for conference room or sports bars and banquet areas.
50. Special effects lighting for DJ entertainment, Hunter heavy duty ceiling fans.
51. Hammond – suzuki electric organs, digital grand pianos and acoustic pianos.
52. Souvenir and gift shop products, – digital cameras, AFGA photo laboratory equipment, film and chemistry, with installation and training of staff.”.
