

*Tourism Incentives (Island Motor Sports Inc.) Order***SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2016, No. 13

[February 8, 2016]

In exercise of the power conferred under sections 3, 5 and 13 of the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30, the Minister responsible for tourism, with the approval of Cabinet, makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Island Motor Sports Inc.) Order, 2016.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, “tourism products” mean-
- (a) buggy adventure tours by Island Motor Sports Inc.; and
 - (b) a picnic facility by Island Motor Sports Inc.

Approved tourism projects

3. The procurement of buggies for the operation of buggy adventure tours by Island Motor Sports Inc. and the provision of picnic tables for the recreational activities by patrons of Island Motor Sports Inc. are declared approved tourism projects.

Declared benefit with regard to import duty

4. Subject to sections 6 and 7, the declared benefit with regard to import duty is a one hundred per cent waiver of import duty on-
- (a) construction materials in the case of the provision of picnic tables for recreational activities by patrons;
 - (b) furniture to furnish a picnic facility; and
 - (c) thirty buggies and safety gear required for buggy adventure tours of Island Motor Sports Inc.

Tourism Incentives (Island Motor Sports Inc.) Order

Declared benefit with regard to excise tax

5. Subject to sections 6 and 7, in the case of the operation of Buggy adventure tours by Island Motor Sports Inc., the declared benefit with regard to excise tax is a one hundred per cent waiver of excise tax on thirty buggies required for that tourism product.

Period of declared benefits

6. The declared benefits under sections 4 and 5 are applicable for a period of five years commencing on the 1st day of August, 2015 and terminating on the 31st day of July, 2020.

Conditions

7. The declared benefits in sections 4 and 5 are subject to the conditions that-

- (a) the importation of the items for the approved tourism projects must meet the prior approval of a Bill of Quantities by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries;
- (b) the management of Island Motor Sports Inc. submits a bi-annual report to the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries from the date of commencement of the approved tourism projects; and
- (c) Island Motor Sports Inc. complies with all other monitoring requirements specified by the Ministry of Tourism, Heritage and Creative Industries.
