

## SAINTLUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2004, No. 15

[ 13th April, 2004 ]

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 19 of the Aliens (Licensing) Act No. 20 of 2002, the Minister responsible for Finance, makes the following Order:

### **Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Aliens Licensing (Exemption) (DCG Properties Ltd.) Order, 2004.

### **Exemption**

2. Subject to paragraph 3, DCG Properties Ltd., is exempted from the provisions of the Aliens (Licensing) Act No. 20 of 2002.

### **Condition**

3. The exemption granted under paragraph 2 is subject to the payment of the prescribed fees in Schedule 2 of the Act and is solely for the purchase of and or by way of conveyance by emphyteutic lease the immovable properties described in the Schedule hereto.

### **Schedule**

- (a) Parcels 1834B 30, 5, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 21; Parcels 0847C 81 and 89; Parcel 1839B 38;
- (b) 195 acres more or less of all that immovable property situate at Fond D'Or, in the Quarter of Dennery, and to be dismembered from Parcel 1840B 177.
- (c) Queen's Chain properties abutting the said 195 acres more or less mentioned in (b) above and registered as Parcel 2038B 30.
- (d) Queen's Chain property at Praslin abutting Parcel 1834B 30 and registered as Parcel 2034B 1.
