ANACT to provide for the expenditure during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March two thousand and three upon certain services in excess of the Appropriation Act 2002/2003.

[20th October, 2003]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same as follows:

No.26] *Supplementary Appropriation Act* [2003.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 2002/2003.

Appropriation of \$126,516,185 for the services of the State for the year 2002/2003.

2. There shall be and there is hereby granted to Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors for the year ending thirty-first March, two thousand and three, the sum of one hundred and twenty-six million, five hundred and sixteen thousand, one hundred and eighty-five dollars, to be paid out of the Consolidated Fund of Saint Lucia for the year and to be applied and expended in the manner mentioned in the Schedule to this Act.
