SAINT LUCIA

No. 19 of 2003

AN ACT to amend the Pensions Act No. 9 of 1967 in certain respects and to provide for matters connected therewith.

[19th May, 2003]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

No. 19] *Pensions (Amendment) Act* [2003.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Act 2003.

Amendment of section 6

2. Section 6 of the Pensions Act No 9 of 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the “Principal Act”) is amended by:

- a) repealing the proviso to section 6 (1) (b) (ii); and
- b) repealing section 6 (2).

Amendment of section 19

3. Section 19 of the Principal Act is amended by adding the following subsection (3) after subsection (2):

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) the provisions of this Act shall not apply to officers first appointed to the public service of the Government of Saint Lucia on or after the 1st day of February 2003.”

Amendment of First Schedule

4. The Principal Act is amended in the First Schedule by:

- a) revoking regulations 6 and 13; and
- b) removing the reference to regulation 6 in regulation 19 (d).
