

Short title and commencement

1.— 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Act 2012.

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be fixed by the Minister by Order published in the *Gazette*.

Interpretation

2. In this Act “principal Act” means the Customs Duties Act, Cap.15.04.

Amendment of section 2

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended —

(a) by deleting the definition of “Customs Tariff” and substituting the following definition:

““Customs Tariff” means the Common External Tariff of the Community referred to in Schedule 4;”;

(b) by deleting the definition of “tariff headings” and substituting the following definition:

““tariff headings” means the headings in the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System for the classifications of goods in the Customs Tariff;” and

(c) by inserting the following definitions in the proper alphabetical sequence:

““Community” has the same meaning assigned to it in the Schedule to the Caribbean Community Act, Cap.19.21;

“Minister” means the Minister responsible for customs;”.
